Allestree Juniors enforce the Football Associations Safeguarding Children Policy

- 1. The children's welfare is and must always be the paramount consideration.
- 2. All children and young people have a right to be protected from abuse regardless of their age, gender, gender reassignment, sexual orientation, marital status, or civil partnership, racial origin, faith, ability, disability, pregnancy and maternity.
- 3. All suspicions and allegations of abuse will be taken seriously and responded to swiftly and appropriately.
- 4. Working in partnership with other organisations, young people and their parents/carers is essential.
